## **Timetable Changes**

As you know we have made changes to the structure of the school day. There has been no change to the lessons that the children have—these are still in the same order each day and an hour long. Lunchtime has moved to after Lesson 4 and it has been shortened from an hour to forty five minutes in line with the vast majority of Hertfordshire schools. The fifteen minutes saved have been allocated to travel/transition time between lessons. Assemblies and House Group time is at the end of the school day.

#### **Road Safety**

Please remind your children about road safety. We have noticed that some students are crossing the road with their hoods up, and not looking properly when they are crossing the road, particularly by the school entrance. Please be aware that some staff members start after 8.30 and are driving onto the school site at the same time as the students are arriving, and so there is still traffic coming into the school site and students should be safe, and vigilant.

#### **Ralph Sadleir Award**

We are introducing the Ralph Sadleir Award this year. It is based on aspects of the Duke of Edinburgh Award and awards given at local secondary schools.

The students are able to work towards bronze, silver or gold awards in the following areas:

- House/Behaviour points
- Attendance
- Taking part in House activities and competitions
- School Community Service
- Home Community Service
- Taking part in extra curricular activities —both at school and outside
- Learning/developing a new skill—outside the classroom

A bronze award earns one point, a silver earns two and a gold earns three points. At the end of the school year the children's points are added up and depending on their total points they will earn a Bronze, Silver of Gold Ralph Sadleir Award 2023-2024. For those students who are aiming for an overall Gold, they will need to earn an individual gold award in at least 5 of the above categories.


Only Year 8 students who earn a Gold Award will be considered for our annual Gill Bickerstaff prize. Year 7 students who hope to become House and Sports Captains next year must gain at least a Bronze Award this year.

In our weekly House Assemblies there will be public recognition of those students who have gained awards. However, the students will not receive any actual certificates until the end of the school year. This is for two reasons, firstly to prevent them becoming screwed up in the bottom of school bags, but more importantly because we are introducing formal prize giving events in July that parents are invited to come along to.
