


#### **School Dinner Balances**

# **Debt Recovery Procedure**



1 week from date of account \*\*applicable to school meals only; a first reminder is sent from +pay.

2 Weeks

2 weeks from date of account a second reminder is sent from +pay and a call will be made by the Finance Officer.

4 Weeks

4 weeks from date of account third reminder; a call from the Finance Officer and notification in writing via email.

6 Weeks

6 weeks from date of account — Fourth reminder; formal reminder letter.

8 Weeks

8 weeks from date of account Fifth reminder; notification in writing of pending legal proceedings. This will be sent by recorded delivery and states that legal action will be taken if the account is not settled



the account has still not been settled, legal action will be considered by the Resources Committee and/or Headteacher. In determining whether to pursue legal action to recover the debt, the Resources Committee and/or Headteacher will consider, among others, hardship, ill health, the financial impact 10 Weeks on the Academy and on the debtor, and the potential impact of any precedent set.

10 Weeks - Final reminder; legal proceedings. If, after 10 weeks from the date of account,
