#### **Ralph Sadleir Award**

This week the children have been told about the new Ralph Sadleir Award that Mrs Scripps has introduced. They can aim towards the Bronze, Silver or Gold Award by the end of the year. Positive Behaviour Points, School based Community Service, Home based Community Service, taking part in House Events and Attendance are all part of the Award. Year 8 pupils who achieve a Gold Award will be considered to receive the Gill Bickerstaff Award. For those who are in Year 7 children will need to earn the Ralph Sadleir Award this year if they wish to be considered as House Captains in Year 8.

Over 120 children who helped at our recent Open Evening have earnt their Bronze School Based Community Service Awards and can now work towards their silver award.
