The Student Council has told us that they want more consistent systems and routines in school. This week Mrs Scripps introduced our new system for ensuring that all students are focussed when the teacher is talking to ensure optimum learning for all.

S-Sit up straight

L— Listen

A-Answer or ask questions

N—No interrupting/talking

T-Track the adult

We understand that for some students this might take a little time to get used to, but where it has been used this week we are already seeing an improvement in students' attention. 321SLANT is used in successful secondary schools across the country, so we are confident that within time it will bring about improved focus by <u>all</u> students in lessons.

#### **Same Day Detentions**

Research shows that same day detentions are more effective than having a detention several days after an Incident. See the attached information that has an update about our on- call system and detentions.

A reminder that over 90% of our students have never been on call or had an after school detention. We hope this information helps to reassure the parents of those students that we will not tolerate behaviour that is preventing other students from learning.
